We have the good fortune to live and work in beautiful Philadelphia for several months. (Don is on temporary assignment with the city's IT department.)

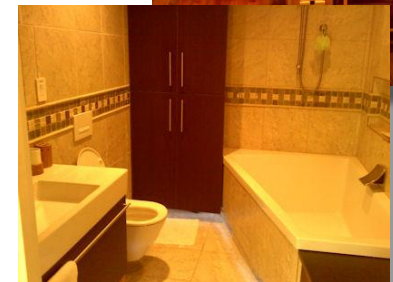
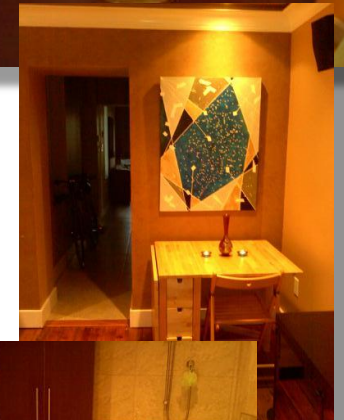
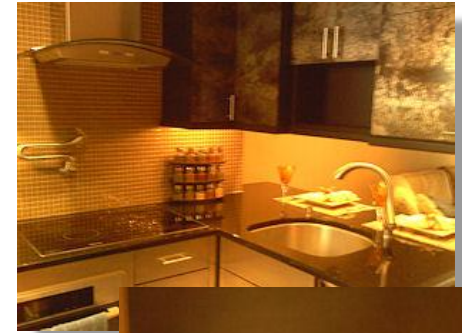

Boathouse Row, Waterworks, Fairmount Park – 8 min. walk

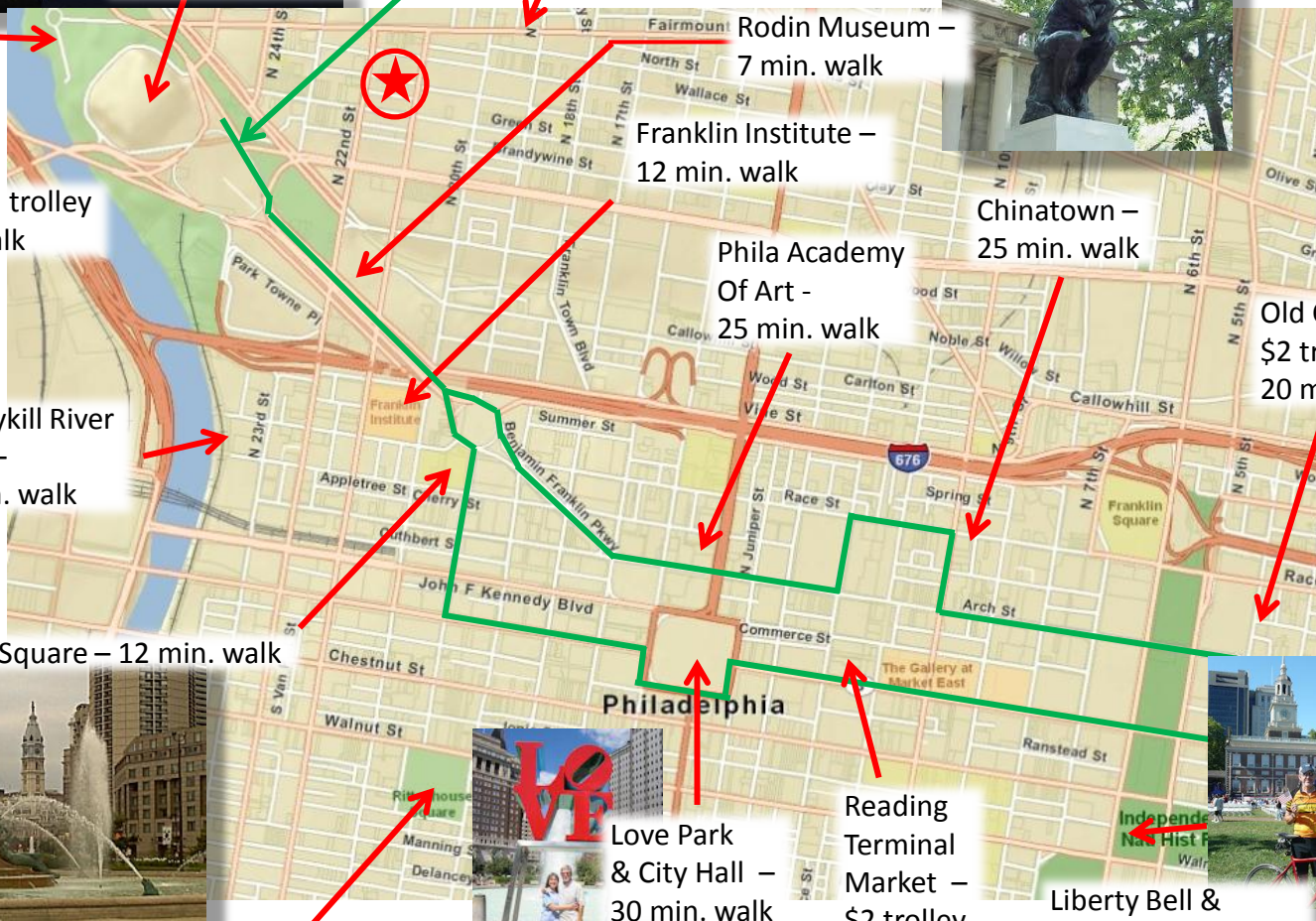


Phila. Art Museum 5 min. walk
