The **Good Samaritan Fund** is a project of the Talbot Association of Clergy and Laity (TACL) that distributes monies to vendors for families who are in need of emergency services, such as rent, utility payments and medical needs. For the previous eleven months, the fund helped 84 people at a cost of \$7,874; Unfortunately, many people are turned away because of lack of funds. Over 99% of all contributions received are disbursed on behalf of people in need. Applicants receive up to \$100 in aid. Often, referrals to other agencies and other resources are provided.

Walt Johnson heads up this effort. Volunteers are being recruited to help with this



important cause. Training will be provided. To volunteer or to learn more, contact Walt at 410-822-2904 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, or Thursdays between 2-4 PM. The fund depends wholly on contributions from TACL fundraisers, including the Interfaith Thanksgiving Service, and donations from member congregations. When
